**Please note that a black belt grading is a high level grading and as so is the only grading where there exists the possibility of "not passing" To pass the student must score a minimum average of 7 out of a possible 10 overall. Not passing a particular skill, ie 6/10 is acceptable as long as the overall average meets the minimum. Although a particular student may be ready to grade, this is in no way a guarantee of passing as the instructors have no control over the individuals performance on the day. If it so happens that a student does not pass, they will still be awarded their black belt on the day (so as not to traumatize the person) but they will be announced as a "probationary black belt". The student will not be permitted to wear the black belt at training and a Kukkiwon certificate will not be applied for until they re-grade at the following grading (a fee of \$100 will be charged for a re-grade).*
